Operation Enforce, our planned response to road safety issues now becomes Op Numbers, as we join with our colleagues from Melton Mowbray to address speeding and anti-social driving/riding across Melton & Rutland

We have recently had our second vehicle at Oakham equipped with ANPR technology, meaning that we are able to not only monitor the extensive ANPR network in Rutland whilst mobile, but we are also able to actively read vehicles using the vehicle mounted cameras.

You will have seen on social media that we have already been active in Braunston in Rutland, South Luffenham, Ketton and Edith Weston, with ANPR monitoring using our existing vehicles, and as duties allow we will continue to work across South Rutland in the same way. Alongside this, Operation numbers will free up staff across the area to focus in the locations you have told us need the most attention.



Officers will be deployed using the ANPR equipped vehicles, along with handheld speed monitoring equipment, meaning we can deal effectively with offenders there and then.

The main aim is promote safe and considerate use of the roads in and around our county, educating where necessary, and dealing with offences in the most appropriate way.
