Thank you for taking the time to write to me. Please forgive my delay, I had thought I had replied to you already, my apologies.

The Product Regulation and Metrology Bill is yet to reach the Commons but when it does, I shall assess the detail of it in greater detail, speak to my colleagues who are experts on this, and of course consider any amendments tabled by MPs.

From what I understand, I expect to welcome many of the precautions taken in this bill, particularly the concept of being able to change the existing regulation more freely as new technology and developments change so do our safety concerns. As lithium batteries become more commonplace concerns around safety will only become more important. I am told that UK fires linked to lithium-ion batteries saw a 46% increase in 2023 compared to 2022, this is a very worrying statistic that needs addressing, and I have had some of those discussions with our local fire brigades.

There are other concerns too regarding slave and child labour, and the risk of benefitting hostile states when sourcing the lithium in the supply chains which I hope can be settled through improved legislation – such as the amends I secured to the Procurement Bill which will hopefully reduce those issues for public procurement. As you may have seen with my opposition to Mallard Pass, I feel strongly about us transitioning any aspect of our energy if it harms communities elsewhere.
