



JC asked how many Social Houses would be</p>

KB responded TBC, part of 10-year plan.</p> <p>ME asked if Local Plan is adapted, will it be impossible to reverse?</p> <p>KB responded Edith Weston had the first Local Plan that was used as the example to others to aspire to, the village would benefit by £ thousands if the officers mess site was developed (houses).</p> <p>Included in general comments:</p> <p>Neighborhood plan and when the wire is taken down? JC asked how many local plans are there? PA observed there would be houses next to a quarry, LA asked why not roll over to 2019, SW Masterplan feedback 312 houses, feels like we are not being listened too.</p> <p>NM shared RAF Wyton proposal for 4,000 houses, the authority stopped it as there was no infrastructure.</p>

Edith Weston will struggle regarding St Georges as time goes on to process the ever-increasing generated documentation burden. North Luffenham main issues are transport and infrastructure compared with Edith Weston issues of proximity and infrastructure.</p> <p>For comparison the 2011 census lists Edith Weston as 818 including MOD and North Luffenham 679 so circa same population.</p> <p>NL asks all present to take the topic away and debate please.</p>
